Program Overview

All Seasons Affordability Program is an owner-occupied rehabilitation program designed to replace old energy-inefficient HVAC units. The Nebraska Housing Developers Association (NHDA) acts as the non-profit sponsor and First National Bank of Omaha is the FHLBank member applicant for this grant funded through FHLBank of Topeka Affordable Housing Program.

Eligible Property Locations: All counties in Nebraska.

**Grant Award:** \$772,500

**Units:** 75

**Commitments:** All units – Completion of homeowner education (Post Purchase) program

delivered by an approved REACH Affiliate Organization/NHDA Approved Provider

All units – Offered Financial Education and/or Credit Counseling, Education/Training Programs, Mental/Behavioral Health Services

42 units – Income at 50% or below AMI 18 units – Income at 60% or below AMI 15 units – Income at 80% or below AMI

**Targets:** 38 units or 50% of the units – Special Needs (55+; Mentally or Physically

disabled; Person recovering from physical, alcohol

or drug abuse; Person recovering from

mental/emotional abuse; Person with HIV/AIDS)

38 units or 50% of the units – Large Units (At least 3 bedrooms)

38 units or 50% of the units – Located in Federally Declared Disaster Area

15 units or 20% of the units – FHLBank Topeka Member Financial Participation

(\$500 Donation – Already Received)

**Application:** Homeowner complete & submit NHDA All Seasons Application

for the potential of being approved loan applications must:

- 1. Be owner-occupied homeowners in Nebraska
- 2. Be a household with income at or below 50%, 60% or 80% AMI
- 3. Meet 2: Be special needs, have a home that is considered a large unit or located in a federally declared disaster area
- 4. HVAC Systems being replaced must meet outlined guidelines

Participation/Fees: Homeowner must apply. Approved REACH Affiliate organizations can be

reimbursed up to \$100 for cost of Post Purchase Homeowner Education; \$1,000 Sponsorship Fee to NHDA for each HVAC rehabilitated home. Maximum of \$500 available for final inspection. Leaving an average of approximately

\$8.800 available for the actual HVAC rehabilitation.
